SIM Interests for West End Development

Overall Goal:

To create multi-function rooms that provide optimum privacy necessary for concurrent use.

What to do First:

Front lobby and connected rooms as outlined below.

Cubicles in Lobby:

Eliminate cubicles to create a single large room that can be used as a "movement" room, for large classes or function as a second Dharma hall.

If the back cubicle stays, enclose the space with doors on both ends to reduce visual clutter.

Two offices Next to the Old Teller Room:

Create a single room with solid walls and a solid door that faces into the lobby (similar to the current small meeting room next to the SIM office) for sound proofing for meeting, interviews, small classes and other functions.

This option would meet the essential need and goal of having two private, separate rooms for smaller functions.

Old Teller Room:

Room size would remain the same. Add large sliding doors or glass doors facing into the lobby to provide privacy when closed and a large area for events when opened.

Location of library:

In the remodeled old teller room with a combination of built-in shelving and shelving that can be moved when needed (on wheels).

Flooring:

Select flooring with the longer term in mind for durable, multi-use with appearance and color that is welcoming, comfortable and consistent with the quality of the building.

Depending on these features, the floor for the lobby, teller room and both meeting rooms could be of the same material.
