One-Day Retreat with Senior Teacher Kamala Masters Saturday, February 27, 2016

"The Integration of Love and Wisdom"

DESCRIPTION:

The spirit of this retreat will strengthen our ability to maintain an enduring quality of awareness not only in retreat, but also so that it can extend into our daily lives in a seamless way. We will be exploring the Four Foundations of Mindfulness with more emphasis on awareness of the qualities of mind. We will explore how we can more clearly uncover the wisdom in our minds by strengthening the loving kindness in our hearts.

The retreat schedule will include periods of sitting meditation and stillness in the Dharma Hall, interspersed with walking practice. The retreat will be held in Noble Silence, and will include complete meditation instructions with Q&A afterwards, group practice discussions, eating and resting as opportunities to maintain continuous awareness, and a formal Dharma talk. This retreat is suitable for both beginning and experienced meditators.

Kamala Masters is one of the founders and teachers of the Vipassana Metta



Foundation on Maui. She teaches retreats in the Theravada tradition at venues worldwide, including being a Guiding Teacher and member of the Board of Directors at the Insight Meditation Society at Barre, Massachusetts. Practicing since 1975, her teachers have been the late Anagarika Munindra of India and Sayadaw U Pandita of Burma, and Sayadaw U Tejaniya of Burma with whom she continues to practice. Kamala has a commitment to carrying and offering the purity of the teachings of the Buddha in a way that touches our common sense and compassion as human beings, and allows the natural inner growth of wisdom. She lives on Maui where she raised

four children, and is now blessed with five grandchildren. Kamala has practiced both insight and loving kindness meditations intensively under the guidance and preceptorship of Sayadaw U Pandita, in the USA, Australia and in Burma as a nun and a laywoman.
